What do the houses look like? How do we travel around? What does the art look like?


And where do you see art in your city?

Some children will even build houses and streets. Together, we'll create a giant city of light!





To imagine your dream house, you use your imagination. Some artists are very good at using their imagination, and because of that, they have designed special and unique houses.

- Do you know what an artist is?
- Do you know what designing means?

Next, we're going to look at some houses that were designed by artists. Look carefully and then tell us what you see!

Houses made by artists:

Look, these houses by artist James Rizzi are super cheerful and full of colors!

They have smiling faces, hearts, and funny shapes on the walls.

It almost feels like the houses want to play with you!

This house in **Mexico** looks like a giant snail with lots of cheerful colors.

Inside, it's like a cave with round, wobbly walls.

It feels as if you're living in an underwater fairytale!

Look, this house looks like it's melting or wobbling! It's located in **Poland**. The designer and builder of this house used a fairy tale as inspiration to come up with the idea.

Misaki Kawai creates cheerful art with soft shapes and bright colors.

She builds funny little houses out of fabric, wood, and paper. Her work looks like toys or a dream world. Everything can be a little silly — that's exactly what makes it fun! It instantly makes you want to look, laugh, and maybe even create something yourself.



Look, this building is called **the Evoluon**. It looks like a giant flying saucer that has landed on Earth. In the past, you could learn all kinds of things here about technology and inventions. Now you can see exciting things and enjoy beautiful lights!

OPDRACHT

Create your own dream house.

Step 1: Think about what your dream house will look like (color, shape, texture).

Step 2: Once you know what your dream house will look like, draw it big inside the dream cloud. Use markers, fineliners, and (colored) pencils.

Step 3: Color your house and fill in all the white space inside the dream cloud, so you also think about what can be seen around the house.
